

HOW TO HANDLE COVID-19 CONTACT TRACING

STUDENTS

Students identified as a close contact, whether vaccinated or unvaccinated, should continue to wear a mask at all times indoors and when in groups outdoors. If you test positive for COVID-19 at any point, you will need to go into isolation.

	I'VE BEEN VACCINATED	I HAVE NOT BEEN VACCINATED
Do I need to <u>quarantine</u> ?	No	Yes
When do I need to get a COVID-19 test?	After 3-5 days, or immediately if symptomatic	Test immediately and at day 5-7, or as soon as symptoms develop
Can I stay in my on-campus residence?	Yes	No
Can I stay in my off-campus residence?	Yes	Yes, but you should quarantine from any roommates.
Can I attend in-person classes?	Symptomatic: Get tested ASAP; don't attend class until the test result returns Asymptomatic: Get tested; you may attend class unless symptoms arise or you receive a positive test result	No
Do I need to wear a mask?	Yes	Yes
How long is the process?	Monitor for symptoms for 14 days	Quarantine for 10 days after last known contact and monitor for symptoms for 14 days
